#### **COMPETITION & GAMES INFORMATION**

**Games kick off at 10.00am with last games being played at 2.30pm.** Following the final games there will be a presentation for all grade winners. This will be held in the Pioneer Rugby Football Clubrooms.

Games will start & finish on the referee. Please ensure you are on the field ready to go at start time.

Footwear must be rugby boots. Mouth guards must be worn.

#### Games will be 16-minutes long, with 8-minute halves.

Half time will consist of changeover of ends – maximum 1 minute allowance for half time.

Subs will only be permitted at half time.

Each referee will keep score, and this will be taken as confirmed score.

All teams to please have their own first aid kits.


#### **SPECTATOR**
