The role balances strategic leadership with hands-on delivery, ensuring that Leaders, the CFO, Business Leaders, and Executive are equipped with the tools, insights, and support they need to make effective decisions and achieve NZR's growth objectives.

Financial Leadership

- Be the lead support to the CFO and Executive Team on financial analysis to support strategic decision making.
- Provide proactive and expert advice to the Executive Team and senior leaders on financial matters, ensuring Finance is a trusted partner across the organisation.
- Ensure Finance business partnering strategies and initiatives are integrated across the business, supporting financial maturity and long-term sustainability.
- Lead the annual budgeting and planning process, conjunction with the Financial Controller and Head of Strategy Planning and Performance.

Financia Business Partnering

- Lead and support the business partnering team to act as NZR's lead finance partners, to ensure that financial implications across all areas are recognised and addressed
- Support the team to provide expert guidance on financial advice to Budget Managers, including:
 - Budgeting and forecasting
 - o Variance analysis and commentary
 - o Commercial contracts and revenue streams
 - o Financial risk assessment and mitigation
 - o Investment and project evaluation



- Maintain a deep understanding of portfolio financials (revenue, costs, and drivers) to enable effective decision making.
- Influence and challenge Senior Leaders constructively, ensuring financial implications are understood and managed.

Management Accounting, Analysis & Reporting

- Oversee the preparation of variance analysis and insights for the Executive Leadership Team and Board in the monthly management finance reporting.
- Ensure accuracy and timeliness of forecasts across all business units.
- Provide high-quality financial insights, linking performance to strategic objectives.
- Lead continuous improvement of financial reporting systems, budgeting tools, and processes.

Project Support

- Act as lead Finance Partner on major projects and negotiations, such as:
 - o Broadcast and sponsorship agreements
 - o Player funding and collective agreements
 - o Large-scale competitions and tournaments
 - o Community rugby initiatives and government funding
- Contribute to enterprise-wide initiatives by ensuring financial considerations are embedded in decisionmaking.
- Provide strategic input into funding agreements, commercial opportunities, and investment cases.

Compliance & Risk

- Ensure awareness and adherence to all relevant financial, legal, and regulatory requirements.
- Oversee risk identification, monitoring, and reporting processes in relation to financial management.
- Promote and maintain best practice internal control frameworks across the business.

Efficiency & Continuous Improvement

- Drive adoption of innovative financial practices and tools, leveraging technology to improve reporting, forecasting, and analysis.
- Champion financial literacy across the organisation, building capability and confidence in budget managers.
- Identify and implement process improvements that enhance efficiency, accuracy, and impact.

Relationship Management

- Establish credibility and trusted advisor status with the Executive Leadership Team and senior leaders across the organisation.
- Build strong relationships with external stakeholders including Provincial Unions, Super Rugby Clubs, auditors, sponsors, and agencies.
- Collaborate across the Finance team to ensure alignment and shared success.

Leadership

- Lead and support a team of Finance Business Partners and Management Accountants, developing
 capability, setting clear direction, and fostering a culture of accountability, collaboration, and continuous
 improvement.
- Provide management and direction to the team in the development of business and operational plans to support the whole organisation.



- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, external parties and other networks as required.
- Contribute to the development of a culture of operational excellence.

- Maintain awareness of any changes in legal or compliance requirements which impact NZR.
- Undertake other tasks as required and work to meet the wider team and organisational objectives.
