Tournament Format:

All team reserves, coaches and managers must be situated and remain in their team/coach boxes on the sideline.

Tournament Dinner:

Dinner will be held at Hotel Ashburton, Racecourse Road, Ashburton. Please arrive 5:30pm for 6pm start.

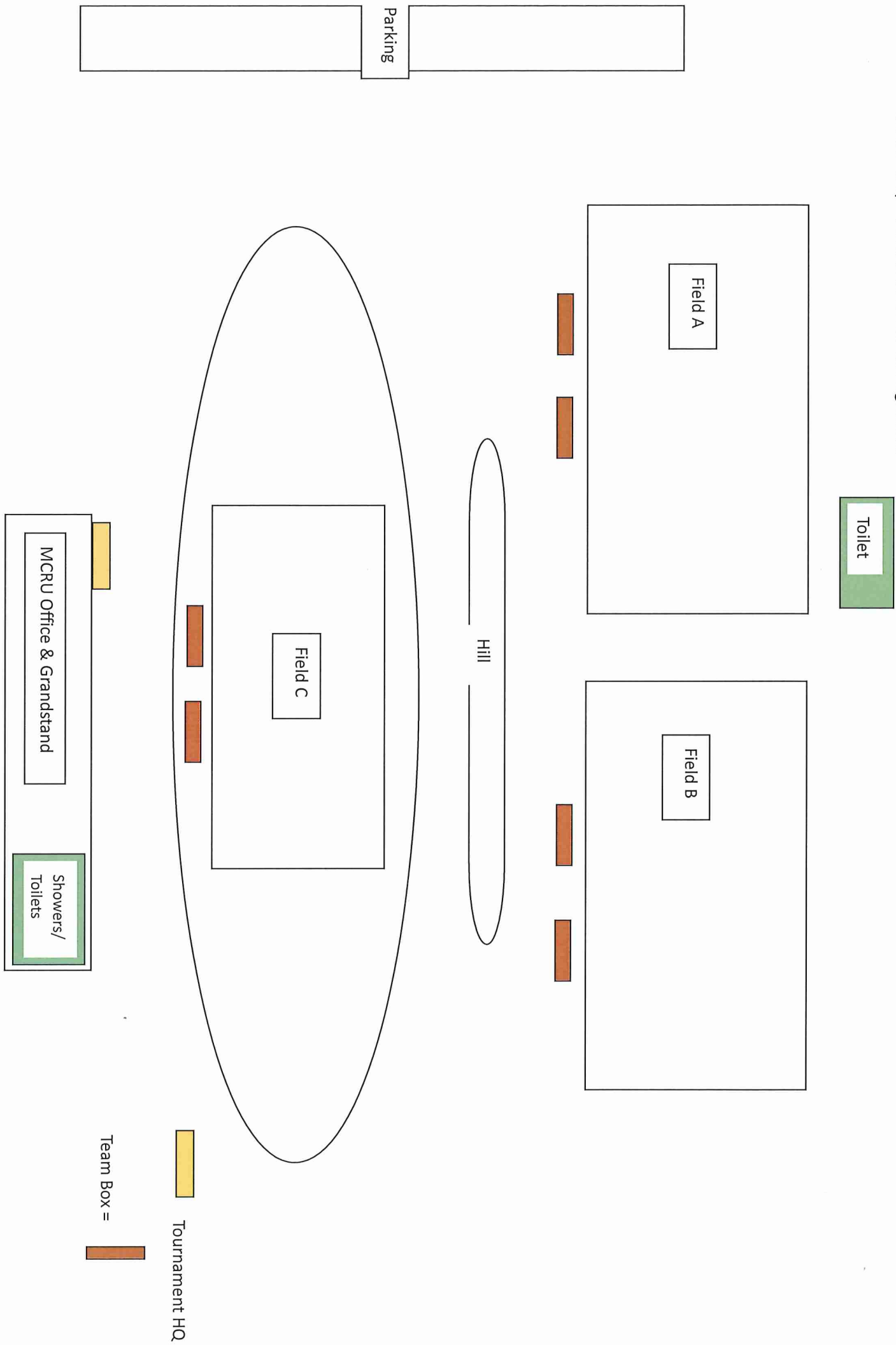
