We will appoint two Forwards Coaches and two Backs Coaches to prepare players for the four-day camp at NZCIS in Wellington, where the top 50 female U20 players will assemble. The camp will conclude with an internal match and game-type scenarios designed to test the athletes' readiness to progress through the pathway.

As a coach, you will work alongside the Women's HP Management Team to create a performance-driven, athlete-centred environment. You'll contribute to all aspects of preparation—training sessions, game-day strategy, and player development—while helping athletes thrive both on and off the field.

- Provide clear, constructive feedback to players and assist in their ongoing development within the high-performance pathway.
